Steven Fong is a founding partner of Khoury Levit Fong, and an architect, urban designer and academic. After graduating from Cornell University, he worked with Dolf Schnebli in Zurich and Barton Myers in Los Angeles. Fong's achievements include several award winning architectural designs (Progressive Architecture Design Award, Association of Collegiate Schools of Architecture Design Award, and The Canadian Architect Design Award), numerous exhibition installations for the Art Gallery of Ontario (Keith Haring, Anish Kapoor, Cindy Sherman, Andy Warhol, Rachel Whiteread), and work on emerging urbanism around the world. His collaborations on urban and regional projects include district plans in China in Shanghai (Suzhou Creek and Jaiding), Beijing (Xidan), Changsha, Chengdu and Qing Pu, as well as planning in the Dubai Marina, UAE. Projects in the Greater Toronto Area include the West Donlands Block Study, Main Streets By-law Analysis, Etobicoke Motel Strip Study, Toronto Waterfront Plan and Gardiner Expressway Study. His report, Finch/Weston Incremental Growth, has informed the City of Toronto's "Avenues" policies in the new Official Plan.

He has worked with the Neptis Foundation and received grants from Canada Council and the Graham Foundation for research on communications strategies and mapping techniques, He is a former Chairman of the Program in Architecture at University of Toronto and former Dean of the College of Architecture at Kent State University. He has taught, lectured, or reviewed at Carnegie Mellon, Columbia, Daltech, ETH Zurich, Harvard, Ohio State University, Princeton, Rice, Syracuse, University of Minnesota, University of Virginia, and Yale. He is an Adjunct Associate Professor at University of Toronto.
